## Girl Scout Camp-Out and Day at the Farm.

Camp-site set up is at 4pm, Friday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>, on the banks of Historic Battle Creek. Then the adventure begins with a flashlight journey through our 7 acre Nighttime Corn Maze.

Saturday, September 24th the girls will explore Honeysuckle Hill Farm with their family and friends!

We have several different discounted ticket options:

**Scout Ticket \$16.00** includes Admission to the farm for one day, Cow Train Ride, Pumpkin Train Ride, 1 bag of gems for Gemstone Mine

**Adult Ticket \$11.00** includes admission to the farm for one day, and one Pumpkin Train ride

Our Regular General Admission Ticket is also available at \$9.00 per person

**Camping pass is additional \$5.00 per person;** this is in addition to the admission ticket you have already purchased. Campers will be allowed on the Farm Friday after 6pm for no additional charge.

Check in 4pm, Friday, September 23 - Check out 6pm, Saturday, September 24

Keep your wrist band on at all times. You must have your wristband to enter the camp site area and Honeysuckle Hill Farm! If you lose your wristband you will have to purchase a new one for \$9.00

## Camping Schedule:

**Friday 4pm-6pm** -Check in at the Honeysuckle Hill Farm Group Admission Bldg.

**Friday 6-10pm** -Honeysuckle Hill Farm is open. (We ask that you begin to return to the camp site no later than 10pm)

**Friday 11pm** - Lights out at the campsite! We will cut off the generator.

**Saturday 10am-** Honeysuckle Hill Farm Opens for business. We will begin serving food at 11am.

**Saturday 6pm** - We ask that you have everything out of the campsite. Honeysuckle Hill Farm will be open until 10pm.

**Dad Zone** – per the Girl Scout rules men cannot sleep in the same space as girl members, therefore we will supply a special roped off area just for the men in the family.

**TRASH** - We will supply each group with trash bags at the time of admission – please use them for any trash and make sure to close them tight when you are done. You can just leave them in the field and we will pick them up!

**FIRE**- We will have a large bonfire for you to cook around or just warm up next to – we ask that you do not start any fires on the ground in the campsite; however you may use a grill for cooking!

**WATER** – You are welcome to go into the creek at your own risk. We will have caution tape up at each end that you must not go past. We do not have running water available.

**RESTROOM** – We will have several Portable toilets set up at the campsite & have restroom facilities at Honeysuckle Hill Farm.

**FOOD** – Honeysuckle Hill Farm has a concession that is open when the farm is open, we begin serving lunch around 11:30 am.

**FLASHLIGHTS** – The farm is dark at night, a flashlight would be advisable, especially while adventuring through our Nighttime Corn Maze!
